PROJECTS STRONG GROWTH TO CONTINUE

ALTAMONTE SPRINGS, Fla. – May 16, 2005 – NCG Medical, a leading provider in medical software, announced today it increased revenue by thirty percent during the first quarter when compared to the same quarter last year.
